

1853 Utah's first fishing law

AN ACT TO PREVENT THE NEEDLESS DESTRUCTION OF FISH.

~

Be it enacted by the governor and Legislative assembly of the territory of Utah, that the county court of the several counties, are hereby authorized to have jurisdiction of the Fisheries, in their respective counties, and required upon the application of the citizens, to institute such regulations as in their judgment will successfully prevent the needless destrution of fish.
