

1931 Utah Fishing Law

SUPPORT OF STATE GOVERNMENT

*An Act making appropriations for the support of the State government for the period beginning July 1, 1931, and ending June 30, 1933.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Utah:

SECTION 1. General appropriations. The following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any money in the general fund of the State treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the support of the government of the State of Utah and for other purposes, as hereinafter expressed, for the period from July 1, 1931, to June 30, 1933, to wit:

To the governor:

Sec. 5. Fish and game fund. The following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any money in the fish and game fund of the State treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the requirements of the fish and game department for the period from July 1, 1931, to June 30, 1933, to wit:

Office expense .....	10,800.00
Travel .....	44,900.00
Maintenance .....	103,600.00
Equipment .....	8,000.00
Permanent improvements .....	70,000.00
Contingent expense .....	5,700.00
For annual audit .....	1,000.00
