A Proclamation

Whereas, it has become advisable to prohibit fishing in the following waters,  
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Newell B Cook, State and Game Commissioner of the State of Utah, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the laws of Utah, do hereby proclaim and declare that the Provo River from the Olmstead Bridge on the Provo River at the mouth of Provo Canyon to Utah Lake shall be closed to fishing for the entire year of 1933.
