A PROCLAMATION

To Whom it May Concern:

WHEREAS, it has become advisable to open the waters of Navajo Lake, Kane County, Utah, to fishing from October 1 to October 31, 1937,

NOW THEREFORE, I, Newell B. Cook, Fish and Game Commissioner of the State of Utah, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 30-0-7, Revised Laws of Utah 1933, do hereby proclaim and declare Navajo Lake, Kane County, Utah, open to fishing from October 1, 1937, to October 31, 1937.
