STATE OF UTAH
FISHING PROCLAMATION

May 26, 1941

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable to make changes in fishing seasons on certain waters otherwise opened to fishing under Section 30-0-33, Revised Laws of Utah 1933, wherein dates for fishing for game fish are prescribed by the State Legislature,

NOW THEREFORE, I, Newell B. Cook, Fish and Game Commissioner of the State of Utah, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 30-0-7, Revised Laws of Utah, 1933, do hereby proclaim and declare that all waters of the State shall be opened to fishing from June 15 to October 31, 1941, inclusive, except as hereinafter prescribed.

Section 1. PROVIDED, the following waters are hereby declared closed to fishing for the entire year of 1941, to-wit:

STATE FISH HATCHERIES:

All waters within all properties owned or controlled by the State Fish and Game Department for fish hatchery purposes.

BEAVER COUNTY:

The Adobe Yard Slough, between the Beaver State Fish Hatchery and a point approximately 300 feet west of the west property line of Kelly's Hatchery.

BOXELDER COUNTY:

Black Slough, west of Brigham City, and all waters within the Otter Dam Game Preserve, as posted with game preserve signs.

CAGNE COUNTY:

Temple Fork; White Pine Creek; Logan River and its tributaries above a point approximately 100 yards below the junction of Beaver Creek and Logan River, as marked and posted on the ground; Tony Grove Lake; Right Hand Fork of Logan River; the tail races of the Logan City Power Plant and Utah Power and Light Plant and the State Dam in Logan Canyon; the tail races of the Hyrum City Power Plant and the Utah Power and Light Plant in Blacksmith Fork Canyon; all tributaries to Blacksmith Fork above the road at C. L. Anderson's Ranch; and headwaters of East Canyon and Scare Canyon above their junction; the Bass Pond immediately south and east of Wellsville; and all waters within the Cutler Dam Game Preserve, as posted with game preserve signs.

CARFIELD COUNTY:

The following tributaries to Panguitch Lake: Parowan Creek; Deer Creek; Punker Creek; Ipsen Creek and Blue Spring Creek.

UTAH COUNTY:

Birch Swamps Stream; Bradley Canyon and Hop Creek.

KANE COUNTY:

Duck Creek Spring and Duck Creek Lake.

MORGAN COUNTY:

Stoddard Slough from the Stoddard-Milton Road to its source; Francis Creek from its junction with Lost Creek to its source; East Canyon Reservoir 1/4 mile above the dam and East Canyon stream between the Reservoir dam and Tucson, approximately 1/2 mile below the dam.

SALT LAKE COUNTY:

Mountain Dell Reservoir in Parley's Canyon; Porter's Fork in Mill Creek Canyon; City Creek and Mill Creek and its tributaries between 9th East and 33rd South Streets.

SAN JUAN COUNTY:

Dark Canyon Lake and Little Blue Lake in the La Sal Mountains.

SEVIER COUNTY:

Front River below the Johnson Valley Reservoir for a distance of 300 yards; Fishlake for a radius of 250 yards from the south of Twin Creeks; Seven-Mile Creek from the bridge to its source.

SMITH COUNTY:

Holmer Creek; Echo Reservoir for a distance of 1/4 mile above the spillway intake; and Weber River between Echo Dam and Echo Creek; Kimball Creek between Highway #40 and the first railroad crossing north of Highway #40.

UTAH COUNTY:

The Provo River between Knudsen swimming hole and the new bridge near the mouth of the river; and the Right Hand Fork of Payson Canyon.

WASATCH COUNTY:

Provo River downstream from Deer Creek Reservoir Spillway to the junction of Provo River and Deer Creek; all waters flowing into the Strawberry Reservoir; and the Midway Hatchery stream from the Hatchery to the Railroad Crossing over said stream.

WASHINGTON COUNTY:

The upper Enterprise Reservoir.

WEBER COUNTY:

All waters above the mouth of the narrows of the South Fork of the Ogden River; Causar Creek and all its tributaries; Wheeler Creek; Pineview Reservoir 400 feet above the dam and Ogden River between Pineview Dam and the first bridge below the dam.

Section 2. BE IT FURTHER PROVIDED: that the season during which it shall be lawful to fish in certain waters during the year 1941 as provided for under Section 30-9-35, Revised Laws of Utah, 1933, shall be amended as follows:

BEAVER COUNTY:

Kents Lake, from May 18 to June 30, inclusive.

BOXELDER COUNTY:

Locomotive Springs from July 1 to October 31, inclusive.

CACHE COUNTY:

Bear River; Logan River below Menden Lead bridge; and Paliuro Ponds, June 15 to December 10, inclusive; High Creek and Southfield Creek, June 15 to August 15, inclusive.

CARSON COUNTY:

All tributaries emptying into Seefield Reservoir, except Gooseberry CCC Pond, July 1, to October 15, inclusive.

DUCHESSIE COUNTY:

Red Creek and Current Creek above the Victory Highway bridges over said streams; and all lakes and streams above the following points: the mouth of Snake Spring on the Uintah River; the Power Dam now being constructed on Yellowstone River; Moon Lake on Lake Fork; the upper bridge on Rock Creek; Old Mill bridge above Savage's Ranch on North Fork of the Duchesne River; and the West Fork of the Duchesne River above its junction with North Fork of the Duchesne River, from July 1 to October 31, inclusive; the upper lake in Lake Canyon, May 1 to October 31, inclusive.

EMERY COUNTY:

Boulger and Huntington Creeks above their junction, July 1 to October 31, inclusive.

CARFIELD COUNTY:

Tropic Reservoir from July 15 to October 1, inclusive.

IRON COUNTY:

Navajo Lake, June 15 to September 30, inclusive.

MOHAVE COUNTY:

Mono Reservoir, June 15 to December 31, inclusive.

YAVAPAI COUNTY:

Bear Lake, except for a radius of 1/4 mile from the mouth of Swan Creek, May 1 to December 10, inclusive; above mentioned radius from mouth of Swan Creek, July 1 to December 10.

SANPETE COUNTY:

All tributaries emptying into Seefield Reservoir except Gooseberry CCC Pond, July 1 to October 15, inclusive; Gooseberry CCC Pond, June 15 to October 31, inclusive; Ferron Reservoir; Huntington Creek and Badger Creeks above their junctions July 1 to October 31, inclusive; Gunnison Reservoir from May 1 to October 31, inclusive.

SEVIER COUNTY:

Fishlake; Johnson Reservoir; and Seven-Mile Creek below the bridge, June 15 to September 30, inclusive; U. M. Creek, July 1 to October 31, inclusive; Redmond Lake, August 1 to October 31, inclusive.

SUMMIT COUNTY:

All lakes and streams above the following points: The Howell Bridge on the Weber River; Smith and Warehouse above the dam; and South Fork of the Weber River above New Gate, July 1 to October 31, inclusive; Scout Lake at Camp Steiner, July 26 to August 31, inclusive.

UTAH COUNTY:

South Fork of Provo River, July 1 to September 30, inclusive.

WASATCH COUNTY:

Strawberry Reservoir, July 1 to October 15, inclusive, unless otherwise proclaimed later; Provo River and its tributaries and all lakes above the Soapstone Bridge; Little South Fork of Provo River; Red Creek and Current Creek above the Victory Highway bridges over said streams, July 1 to October 31, inclusive.

WAYNE COUNTY:

Blind Lake, June 15 to September 30, inclusive.

BE IT FURTHER PROVIDED that Clear Lake in Millard County shall be closed to fishing and taking of bass during the year 1941. (This does not prohibit fishing for other species of fish in these waters.)

REDUCTION OF BAG LIMITS:

Be it further provided that the bag or creel limit on all species of trout shall be not more than eight (8) pounds or not more than twenty (20) fish in any one day, but if after catching in weight less than eight pounds, a fish of more than the required weight to make eight pounds should be caught, such fish may be kept; and that it shall be unlawful to have in possession at any one time more than sixteen (16) pounds or two days' creel limit of any or all varieties or species of trout.
