

# 1942 Utah Fishing Proclamation

STATE OF UTAH  
FISHING PROCLAMATION  
April 25, 1942

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable to make changes in fishing seasons on certain waters otherwise opened to fishing under Section 30-0-33, Revised Laws of Utah, 1941-1942 wherein dates for fishing for game fish are prescribed by the State Legislature.

NOW THEREFORE, We, the Fish and Game Commission of the State of Utah, by virtue of the authority vested in us by Section 30-0-7, Revised Laws of Utah, 1941-1942, do hereby proclaim and declare that all waters of the State shall be open to fishing from June 14, to October 18, 1942, inclusive, except as herein prescribed:

## SECTION 1

Provided, the following waters are hereby declared closed to fishing for the entire year of 1942, to wit:

### STATE FISH HATCHERIES:

All waters within all properties owned or operated by the State Fish and Game Department for fish hatchery purposes.

### BEAVER COUNTY:

Rookyford Reservoir, above and below the dam, as marked and posted on the ground.

### BOXBLDER COUNTY:

Black Sloughs, West of Brigham City, and all waters within the Cutler Bam Game Preserve, as posted with appropriate signs.

### CACHE COUNTY:

Logan River and its tributaries above a point approximately 100 yards below the junction of Beaver Creek and Logan River; the tail race of the Logan City power plant and the Utah Power and Light Plant; the tail race of the Hyrum City power plant and the area above the Hyrum City power dam; the area around the Utah Power and Light plant in Blacksmith Fork Canyon and the Hyrum Reclamation Dam, as marked and posted on the ground.

### CARBON COUNTY:

Scotfield Reservoir, above and below the dam, as marked and posted on the ground.

### GARFIELD COUNTY:

Pangultch Lake, as marked and posted, above and below the dam; the following tributaries to Pangultch Lake; Parowan Creek; Deer Creek; Bunker Creek; Ipson Creek.

### JUAB COUNTY:

Mona Reservoir; Sevier Bridge Reservoir; Gunnison Bend Reservoir; Delta-Millville Reservoir, above and below the dams, as marked and posted on the ground.

### MORGAN COUNTY:

East Canyon Reservoir above and below the dam, as marked and posted on the ground.

### PIUTE COUNTY:

Otter Creek Reservoir, above and below the dam and Flute Reservoir above and below the dam, as marked and posted on the ground.

### SALT LAKE COUNTY:

Mountain Dell Reservoir in Parley's Canyon; Porter's Fork in Mill Creek Canyon; City Creek and Mill Creek and its tributaries between 9th East and 33rd South Streets.

### SANPETE COUNTY:

Gunnison Reservoir, above and below the dam, as marked and posted on the ground.

### SEVIER COUNTY:

Fremont River below the Johnson Valley Reservoir for a distance of 300 yards; Fishlake, for a radius of 260 yards from the mouth of Twin Creeks; Seven-Mile Creek from the bridge to its source; Forsyth Reservoir, as marked and posted.

### SUMMIT COUNTY:

Helner Creek; Echo Reservoir for a distance of ½ mile above the spillway intake; and Weber River between Echo Dam and Echo Creek; Kimball Creek between Highway No. 40 and the first railroad crossing north of Highway No. 49, as marked and posted on the ground.

### WASATCH COUNTY:

Provo River downstream from Deer Creek and Deer Creek Reservoir, as marked and posted; All waters flowing into Strawberry Reservoir except Indian Creek, up to the Twin Bridges; the Midway Hatchery stream from the Hatchery property to the railroad crossing over said stream, Strawberry Reservoir as posted.

### WEBER COUNTY:

Causeur Creek and all its tributaries; Wheeler Creek; Pineview Reservoir above the dam and Ogden River between Pineview Dam and the first bridge below the Dam, as marked and posted on the ground.

## SECTION 2

Be it further provided: that the season during which it shall be lawful to fish in certain waters during the year 1942, as provided for under Section 30-0-33, Revised Laws of Utah, 1941-1942, shall be amended as follows:

### BEAVER COUNTY:

Kents Lake, from May 18 to June 30, inclusive.

### BOX ELDER COUNTY:

Locomotive Springs from May 1 to October 18, inclusive.

### CACHE COUNTY:

Bear River; Logan River below Mendon Road bridge; and Pelican Ponds, June 14 to December 15, inclusive; High Creek and Smithfield Creek, June 14 to August 16, inclusive.

### KANE COUNTY:

Navajo Lake, June 14 to September 30, inclusive.

### JUAB COUNTY:

Mona Reservoir, May 1 to December 31, inclusive.

### RICH COUNTY:

Bear Lake, except for radius of ¼ mile from the mouth of Swan Creek May 1 to December 15, inclusive; above mentioned radius from mouth of Swan Creek July 1 to December 16.

### SANPETE COUNTY:

Gunnison Reservoir from May 1 to October 31, inclusive.

### SEVIER COUNTY:

Fishlake; Johnson Reservoir; and Seven-Mile Creek below the bridge, June 14 to September 30, inclusive; Redmond Lake, August 1 to October 31, inclusive.

### UTAH COUNTY:

South Fork of Provo River June 14 to September 30, inclusive.

### WAYNE COUNTY:

Blind Lake, June 14 to September 30, inclusive.

BE IT FURTHER PROVIDED, that Yellow Perch may be taken by angling from Utah Lake and Mona Reservoir from May 1 to October 16, inclusive. Black Bass may be taken from Evans Reservoir, Washington County, from May 17 to July 1, inclusive.

## SECTION 3

Provided further, that any water or area not mentioned in Section 1 may, as a defense measure, be closed to fishing by posting, without further notice, with suitable signs or markers.

The bag or creel limit on all species of trout and bass shall be not more than eight (8) pounds or not more than twenty (20) fish in any one day, but if after catching in weight less than eight pounds, a fish of more than the required weight to make eight pounds should be caught, such fish may be kept; and that it shall be unlawful to have in possession at any one time more than sixteen (16) pounds or two days' creel limit of any or all varieties or species of trout.
